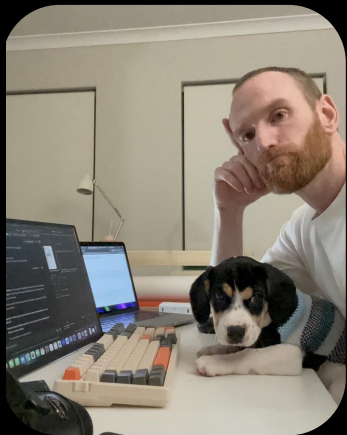

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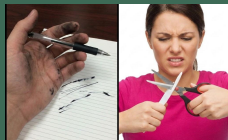

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First in a queue

WAITING in line overnight to get tickets to see your favourite band is not unheard of, but lining up to be the first through the doors of a new retail outlet is something different.

But that is exactly what Tim Daly and Sarah Reading did.

The couple caught a bus and two trains to arrive at the doors of the new Ikea store in Innaloo at midnight last Thursday, to be the first in the queue.

What is more disturbing than their arrival time is the fact that they were still there at 4pm.

However, their efforts did not go unrewarded, with Ikea presenting them with a \$500 voucher each.

Tim said he was "very, very shocked" at being given the voucher and had waited in line for 10 hours for the honour.

"I really, really enjoy Ikea and I

wanted to say that I was the first through the door," he said.

Other customers started arriving at the more civilised hour of 8am and by opening time, there were thousands in the queue.

While shoppers were waiting to get in, Deputy Premier Eric Ripper, Swedish Ambassador Her Excellency Karin Ehnborg-Palmquist, City of Stirling Mayor David Boothman, Alan Tribe, director of Ikea franchisee Cebas, store manager Alan Buckle and more than 150 invited guests were enjoying a function for the official opening of the new store.

Perth's new two-storey 26,600sqm Ikea store is WA's biggest retail tenant building and features a 420-seat restaurant and a new self-service system.

It is four times bigger than Ikea's current Osborne Park location and will have 410 employees, including 120 new staff.

So keen on Ikea

WAITING in line overnight for tickets to see your favourite band is not unheard of, but lining up to be the first through the doors of a new store is quite different.

But that is exactly what Tim Daly and Sarah Reading did.

The Fremantle couple caught a bus and two trains to arrive at the new Ikea store in Innaloo at midnight last Thursday – 10 hours before the shop's official opening – just to guarantee they would be the first through the doors.

Incredibly, the keen shoppers were still at the shop at 4pm – but their long day proved worth their while as Ikea gave them each a \$500 voucher.

Other customers arrived from the more civilised hour of 8am and by the time the

doors opened, there were thousands in the queue. Almost 13,000 people browsed the store on opening day.

The traffic chaos that authorities had predicted could occur was not considered too bad on opening day. However, the City of Stirling expects the next few weekends to present a real test of Ellen Stirling Boulevard's ability to cope with the traffic pressures.

An electronic sign was set up during afternoon peak hour on the Mitchell Freeway, near the Cedric Street exit, warning motorists of delays at Ellen Stirling Boulevard.

The City of Stirling and Main Roads WA will continue to monitor traffic in the area.
